PUPPET CAMP

July 6–July 10

This week-long online exploration of the magic of puppets and storytelling will transform your desktop into a puppet studio. We will design and build hand puppets, needle-felted puppets, finger puppets, shadow puppets and stages and screens for puppet shows. We will build puppets during our daily sessions, and the captioned video instruction for puppet building will also be available for asynchronous viewing.
