Echo Center Academic Enrichment and Project- Based Listening and Spoken Language (LSL) Classes

(EXTENDED SCHOOL YEAR)*

Small-group instruction in foundational curriculum and listening and spoken language skills at your child's developmental level

In each online class, DHH students start their day by connecting with teachers and other EHS peers in a morning meeting designed for social-emotional skill development. The first class of the day will alternate daily between a focus on literacy development (phonics, reading, and writing) and math concepts. The second half of the day will shift to project-based learning that provides an opportunity to engage in small-group interactive activities that focus on IEP goals on listening, spoken language, and social skills development. Each DHH student will have an opportunity to meet with their DHH teacher for 15-minute individual check-ins at least two times a week.

*Please note: Echo Center Academic Enrichment and LSL classes are offered for Session One only (June 22–26 and June 29–July 2). We encourage Echo Center families to attend the Create.Innovate.Play. camps for subsequent weeks.

Academic Enrichment Classes

Small-group instruction in foundational curriculum at your child's developmental level

In each two-hour online class, children start their day by connecting with the teacher and peers in a morning meeting designed for social-emotional skill development. The first class of the day will focus on literacy foundations (phonics, reading, and writing) designed for the appropriate developmental stage of the students. In the second part of the morning session, the class will shift to math concepts using interactive games to practice and develop skills. Research shows that in the online platform, small-group instruction is the most effective for student learning and academic growth.

One-on-One Tutoring

Available for families who seek targeted academic support and development with a dedicated teacher.

Online tutoring sessions will be available for one hour per day, in packages of 5 or 10. The teacher will consult with the parents or guardians and the 2019–2020 classroom teachers before the tutoring package begins, in order to design an instruction plan specific to the needs of your child. One-on-One Tutoring

Targeted one-on-one instruction focused on areas specific to your child's needs

Pre-tutoring consultation with parents/guardians and 2019–2020 classroom teacher included in cost of package.

- Tutoring available in packages of 4 (due to short week of June 29–July 2), 5, or 9 (55 minute sessions daily)
- Tutoring available between the hours of 11AM–4PM
- Tutoring is available for all four weeks of our summer program, June 22–26, June 29–July 2, July 6–10, and July 13–17

Package of 4 sessions: **\$400**

Package of 5 sessions: **\$450**

Package of 9 sessions: **\$800**
